What? Thorough activity Description:

We would like to invite you for a 2 Hour Boat Trip on both Still Waters, a 102-year-old Wooden Tender from the ship, Mauritania, a sister ship to the Titanic or Marion, a 1937 Sailboat. Web will be travelling from Shepherds Patch, Slimbridge, to the Purton Hulks at Purton.

On your journey you will take part in steering Still Waters and Marion who have different ways to steer, and you will be able to experience both boats. When we arrive at Purton you will be taken a short distance to the River Severn where you will see and hear about the Purton Barges where they have been beached since the end of the last world war. You will also hear stories about the River Severn and why the river is so dangerous in this area.

Like a treasure hunt you will be exploring the boats where the footpath will take you along the edge of the River Severn seeing

the wildlife and the skeletons which remain of some of the barges.

The fun of steering the boats and the days' exploring will give you lots of great memories.

Food Provision information:

On return to the Blackshed Cafe at Shepherds Patch we will have a roast dinner, dessert and a soft drink waiting for you.



When the children come to the Blackshed for their lunch staff will greet them and give them a description of the choices on the Carvery and ask the children what vegetables and meat they like.



We will provide a Carvery Lunch, to include freshly cooked vegetables of the season and high welfare meat, followed by a desert of their choice. The carvery offers the children a choice of Cabbage, Cauliflower, Broccoli, Carrots, Parsnips, Peas, Cauliflower & Leek Cheese and other seasonal veg such as Green Beans and Courgettes in the summer. Beef & Pork is locally sourced in the Forest of Dean and are all traceable to local farms. We can offer dietary requirements for example Gluten Free, Vegetarian and Vegan options. We always have Salad as an alternative to vegetables. If a child prefers a cold lunch, we will offer Meat from our Carvery It will be accompanied with a mixed salad, lettuce, tomatoes, radishes, celery, carrot, and roast potatoes. We have a selection of dishes for Vegetarians, again accompanied with a mixed salad as described or hot vegetables. The children will have a choice of desserts, Apple Pie with Ice Cream or

Fresh Fruit. All children will be provided with Fresh Orange or Apple Juice.

For those who have special dietary needs we can provide Vegan, vegetarian and allergen sensitive choices. We have a designated Gluten Free area, equipment and utensils to provide appropriate food to all customers with allergens,
